Supported Florida's public schools with the largest increase in per-student funding since the 2013-2014 school year.



Empowered the families of 18,000 low- and middle-income students to choose the best educational fit for their child through the Family Empowerment Scholarship program.



Improved career education pathways for K-12 and postsecondary students through an annual review to ensure quality course offerings and alignment with regional workforce demands.



Created new initiatives to improve college degree or certificate attainment to 60 percent of Florida adults by 2030.



Ensured more than 2,000 additional students with special needs receive access to a customized education through the Gardiner Scholarship Program.



Protected the 295,000 students who attended a Florida public charter school last year by securing equitable facilities funding of \$158.2 million.



Funded professional development and bonuses for teachers to increase student access to computer science education courses.
